#### **INCOME**

## **RATING**

There has been no increase in rates levied with the Council resolving that both the UV and GRV rate in the dollar for 20/21 will remain at the same level as the previous financial year. This is in response to declarations made as a result of COVID-19 legislation. Total rate income is estimated at \$5,023,646.

The Council has however, experienced a revaluation of UV rated properties as conducted by the Valuer General and this will result in both rate increases and decreases for some individual ratepayers.

### **RUBBISH/RECYCLING**

The annual levy for rubbish/recycling will remain unchanged at \$300 per annum. A portion of this income is used to fund future capital works at the Buller Road Refuse Site.

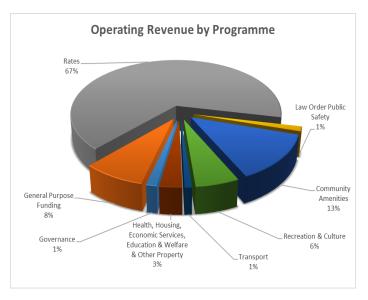

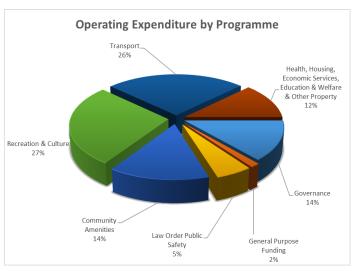
