## DOG REGISTRATION RENEWALS

Dog Registration Renewals have now been sent out and must be paid by the 31st October 2015

Under the provisions of the Dog Act, all dogs within the Shire over the age of 3 months must be registered. Registrations are carried out at the Shire office and are available for lifetime registrations or 1 and 3 year periods, commencing on the 1st November each year.

To obtain a concession rate on registrations for sterilised dogs, a sterilisation certificate must be produced when registering. In town sites the maximum number of dogs is 2 and rural areas the maximum number of dogs if 4. **All dogs must be registered**

Unsterilised 1 year \$50 Unsterilised 3 years \$120 Unsterilised Lifetime \$250 Sterilised 1 year \$20 Sterilised 3 years \$42.50 Sterilised Lifetime \$100

- Working Dogs are 25% of the above fees
- Pensioner Concession Card holders are 50% of the above (a copy of your concession card must be produced when registering)
   Microchipping has now been introduced for all dogs and is compulsory

for ALL registrations.
