Planning and Development (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015
Adoption of Local Planning Policy 12 – Domestic Outbuildings in Rural Lifestyle and Peri-Urban Areas

Council has resolved to adopt the above policy. This policy will apply to domestic outbuildings in the Shire's rural lifestyle and peri-urban zones. The purpose of the policy is to make reasonable provision for the development of domestic outbuildings in the Shire's rural lifestyle and peri-urban zones whilst ensuring the amenity and environmental quality of these areas is not compromised.

Adoption of Local Planning Policy 13 – Waroona Town Centre Development Requirements

Council has resolved to adopt the above policy. This policy will apply to development within the Waroona town centre. The purpose of the policy is to provide a set of development requirements for commercially zoned land to ensure that redevelopment or new development achieves a high standard and enhances visual quality along the town's primary streets.
