



Shire President's Message

Council held its February meeting at the Preston Beach Community Centre. Councillors and staff were delighted at the interest shown by the community with the numbers that attended to watch proceedings. At the meeting we endorsed the Resource Sharing Agreement with the Murray Shire for the next five years as the arrangement has already proven beneficial for both parties and the five year endorsement

gives us the opportunity to set a path into the future and move from the current trial into a formal agreement. The benefit of sharing a very capable CEO has also helped bring about a can do culture and will have savings in costs into the coming years which needs to be an important consideration of our local government.

Following the council meeting at Preston we held the second of three community sundowners which have been well received and well attended. I thank those who have engaged with councillors and staff in an informal setting and have had the opportunity to ask questions and share their aspirations for how our

community could be improved or perhaps point out some of the areas we are doing well and opportunities to enhance them. The sundowners have also given council the chance to show what initiatives and projects we are currently working on and some of the feedback from our strategic planning forums.

I was fortunate to have been invited to the opening of the new Early Learning Hub at St Joseph's Primary School. These new rooms were bright and will certainly enhance the early development of our young ones in our community. The natural playground is a stunning addition and I wish to congratulate the School board and the wonderful

teachers and staff at St Josephs for a great outcome for our community in early education.

The Alcoa Wagerup Sustainability Fund is currently open to the community and I encourage any community group to submit their applications by the 10th of April. The full list of conditions and guidelines are on the Shires website. In conjunction with these grants are the Shire's Community Development Grants up to the value of \$800. The applications for these are also on the website and close at the end of March. Please consider applying for some of this funding if you are entitled to do so.

ALCOA WAROONA SUSTAINABILITY FUND 2020 GRANTS

Community groups and organisations in the Shire of Waroona are invited to submit applications for grants from the Alcoa Waroona Sustainability Fund.

The Sustainability Fund purpose is to fund facilities and projects with enduring value for the communities surrounding the Wagerup refinery. Funds will be allocated to community organisations, initiatives, processes and activities that contribute to the local government region known as the Shire of Waroona.

The closing date for applications is Friday 10 April 2020.

To be eligible you must be an incorporated community group and/or organisation who is domiciled and provides services predominately within the Shire of Waroona including, but not limited to, Waroona, Lake Clifton, Preston Beach, Nanga Brook, Wagerup and Hamel.

Applications can be for a broad range of community development projects both large and small that make a positive contribution to the economic, social, recreational or environmentally sustainability of the communities within the Shire of Waroona.

Projects that attract matched or partial funding from other sources and promote the concept of co-location (where appropriate) will be encouraged.
