 Compliance with the provisions of the Liquor Control Act 1988 Orderly conduct being maintained. Cabaret, Balls, etc Organisers of Cabaret, Balls or other functions are required to make application to the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor for a "Function Permit" to sell liquor in the Hall or on the Town Oval/surrounds and fourteen (14) days' notice of intention are required. This also applies if an entry fee is charged, and supply of liquor is included in charge. Bottled beer, cans etc may be consumed in the Main Hall and external area of the north side of the building, which is to be secured, or in the case of events on the oval/surrounds, within the designated (roped off) bar areas. No kegs to be placed or served from in the Hall. Any breach of the above conditions may result in the refusal of a Liquor Permit for any future function to be conducted.
