 Compliance with the provisions of the Liquor Control Act 1988 Orderly conduct being maintained. Organisers of functions where there is intent to sell liquor are required to make application to the Department of Local Government, Sport & Cultural Industries. This also applies if an entry fee is charged, and supply of liquor is included in the charge. Applications must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the event. Bottled beer, cans etc may be consumed in the Main Hall and external area of the north side of the building, which is to be secured, or in the case of events on the oval/surrounds, within the designated (roped off) bar areas. No kegs to be placed or served from in the Hall. Any breach of the above conditions may result in the refusal of a Liquor Permit for any future function to be conducted.
